Fathers & Families Support Center OUTCOMES

In 2024...

- **259 dads and moms** graduated from FFSC's programs, becoming more responsible parents through FFSC's programs.
- **782 sons and daughters** were positively impacted by having more responsible parents who can support them emotionally, developmentally and materially through FFSC's comprehensive programs.
- 83% of participants reported increased parenting skills.
- 75% of FFSC participants report increased interaction with their children.
- 72% of participants reported increased co-parenting relationship skills.
- **3% Recidivism rate** for participants of FFSC's Re-Entry Project. The 2024 Missouri average recidivism rate is 35%.
- Average wage that FFSC participants earned in 2024 was \$18.16/hour compared to the state's minimum wage of \$12.30.
- 298 participants agency-wide obtained or maintained employment, resulting in \$10.7M reinvested back into the local economy.
- Between 2019 2024, FFSC helped the State of Missouri collect \$5,926,609 in child support paid by Family Formation participants.
- For every \$1 invested, FFSC returns nearly \$5.00 to the St. Louis Community.
- Since its first class in May 1998, FFSC has positively impacted nearly 22,000 men on their journey to Responsible Fatherhood, benefitting over 53,000 children with parents who can support them emotionally, developmentally and materially.
